

Communications and Media Position: The Free State Foundation is accepting applications for a position that will help FSF further promote its work to the general public and to the media. The position requires the skills necessary to maintain and upgrade FSF's website, blog, and messaging vehicles; to increase the Foundation's exposure by obtaining enhanced recognition of the Foundation's free market-oriented work in prominent national media and trade press outlets and through the use of social and digital media networks; to prepare press releases, commentaries, and other promotional materials; and to promote Foundation conferences and seminars. The applicant needs to demonstrate that he or she already possesses prior experience relevant to accomplishing the above tasks at a high skill level. The ability to write well – that is, to express what you are saying clearly, using proper grammar – is an absolute requirement. Prior experience and existing expertise in the areas of communications policy and intellectual property from a free market and property right-oriented perspective are a plus. The position may be full-time or part-time. A considerable amount of the work may be performed by telecommuting. Compensation is commensurate with experience and expertise.

Fellow Position: The Free State Foundation is accepting applications for a position that requires excellent research and writing skills accompanied by existing expertise in “law and economics” fields. In fact, applicants will be required to demonstrate the possession of excellent writing skills in order to receive any consideration. And prior experience and existing knowledge of communications law and policy and intellectual property issues is a definite plus, and depending on the Foundation's needs at the time, perhaps an absolute prerequisite. The position may be full-time or part-time. A considerable amount of the work may be performed by telecommuting. Compensation is commensurate with experience and expertise.
