Seth Cooper Joins FSF As Research Fellow

ROCKVILLE, MD – Free State Foundation President Randolph May announced today that Seth Cooper has joined the Free State Foundation on a full-time basis as Research Fellow. Prior to joining FSF, Seth served as Telecommunications & Information Technology Task Force Director and Amicus Counsel for the American Legislative Exchange Council, the nonpartisan organization representing state legislators devoted to free market, limited government, and federalism principles. For the past year, Mr. Cooper has also served as an Adjunct Fellow at FSF. Prior to coming to Washington, DC, he served as staff counsel for the Senate Republican Caucus of the Washington State Senate.

In announcing Cooper's appointment, May stated: "I am very pleased that Seth has joined FSF on a full-time basis. Seth brings to his new position a wealth of knowledge and experience in communications and high-tech policy issues, as well as expertise on various state policy issues. As an adjunct, he already has contributed significantly to FSF's success over the past year, and I know, now that he has come on board full-time, he will contribute even more significantly to FSF's continued growth and influence as a leading free market-oriented think tank."

Upon joining FSF, Mr. Cooper stated: "It is an honor for me to join the Free State Foundation as Research Fellow. The next several years will be very important ones with respect to the development of sound communications policy and other public policies.
