



## **Free State Foundation Privacy Policy – Revised June 29, 2020**

This website, [www.freestatefoundation.org](http://www.freestatefoundation.org), is operated by The Free State Foundation. This Privacy Policy describes the personal information we collect when you visit the site and how we use the information we collect.

### **Information We Collect:**

#### Personal Information

Personal information is any information that allows us to identify you individually, such as your name, phone number, mailing address or email address. To use certain features of our site, such as contacting us or signing up to receive information from us, you may be required, on a voluntary basis, to provide limited personal information. If you decide you do not want to receive future communications from us, you can opt out of any email communications you receive from us by contacting us at [info@freestatefoundation.org](mailto:info@freestatefoundation.org). We do not collect any of this personal information unless you voluntarily provide it to us.

#### Non-Personal Information

We may collect non-personal information about visits to our site by users, such as the pages visited, the duration of visit, and the frequency of visits. This information is considered non-personal information because it cannot be used to identify you individually. We may gather this non-personally identifiable information regarding usage of our site through the use of such things as cookies that enable us to collect this non-personal information. You may disable cookies, but if you do so some features of the site may not work as anticipated when cookies are disabled.

### **Sharing Your Information:**

Other than as described in this Privacy Policy, we may share or disclose the information we collect: (i) when it is required by law, regulation, legal process or enforceable governmental request; (ii) to enhance or improve the site or your experience with the site; (iii) when we believe disclosure is necessary to protect the safety of our users or the sites; and (iv) with third parties that perform services for us.

### **Social Networking Sites:**

You may share our site and its content with your social network. ### **Children's Privacy:**
